ISU Extension and Outreach Validation of Map Data

- 1. Abstract information forms will be reviewed and determination made if land is a land grant parcel.
- 2. Landowner will be notified of positive validation, or of an error in the map data and invalidation.
- 3. If validation is positive, color of parcel on map will be changed to gold; landowner will receive certificate stating validation of land as a land grant parcel, and invitations to participate in local and state land grant legacy recognitions.
